






2016 National Data

Bureau of Labor Statistics *Census of Fatal Occupational Injuries (CFOI)*

- 33 collection fatalities
- 9 landfill fatalities
- 1 MRF fatality





Collection Fatalities







113 Fatal Incidents Resulting in 117 Fatalities

- Both workers & members of the public
- Occurred during collection & at MRFs, TS, landfills, etc.



36 Solid Waste Workers Died

- 23 drivers and helpers out on collection
- 7 at landfills
- 2 at MRFs
- 1 doing maintenance
- 2 a Transfer Stations
- 1 in the yard



83 members of the public died

- Majority were killed in vehicle accidents
- 21 pedestrians
- 7 bicyclists
- 3 motorcyclists



Wisconsin Fatalities

One worker has already died on the job in 2018 in Wisconsin

 Garbage truck rolled over while exiting a road on a curve in Council Bluffs, IA on February 15.



2018 So Far

23 solid waste-related fatalities

- 16 solid waste workers
- 20 members of the public
- 17 fatalities in January alone
 - One of the worst months in recent memory



2018 So Far

Solid waste employees

- 11 drivers/helpers on collection
- 4 at landfill
- 1 at transfer station

Members of the public

- 16 drivers/passengers in a vehicle
- 2 bicyclists
- 2 motorcyclists
