Presentations will have a duration of 15, 30 or 45 minutes. Each session may have one or multiple presenters or may be in a panel format. **Sessions are planned for Tuesday, October 6.** Please indicate as part of your submittal if you are NOT available for a specific date or time.

### **Review Process**

Speakers are required to submit an abstract. While previous speaking experience is an advantage, new presenters are strongly encouraged to submit.

Each submission will be reviewed by a panel which will focus on:

- 1. Innovation of topic or project
- 2. Relevance to the respective audience
- 3. Overall merit of the abstract: clarity of description, creativity of presentation and scope of objectives

The committee is planning to notify presenters by Friday, May 29.
